IIBF:

Indian Institute of Banking and Finance (IIBF) Examination is conducted by Indian Institute of Banking and Finance (IIBF). This institute offers JAIIB, CAIIB as core courses. Besides that the institute also offer diploma, certificate and management courses in the field of banking and finance. The college ensures that the aspirants get adequate information they require with high standards. Employed people and those seeking jobs in financial sector usually undergo distance learning with IIBF. The three different subjects for the exam will be conducted 2 times a year May/June and November/December on two consecutive Sundays. The centres will be provided along with the application form.

Structure and Pattern of the IIBF

The examination covers three different subjects Principles and Practices of Banking, Accounting and Finance for Bankers, Legal and Regulatory Aspects of Banking. The duration of the exam is 2 hours which is in English medium only. Each question paper will contain 120 objective type questions based on case studies which carry 100 marks. Each question carries one mark only. For any wrong answer 1/8th of one mark will be reduced. Minimum marks to be scored for each subject is 50. Those who are securing 45 marks for each subject should secure an aggregate of 50% to qualify the entrance test. Syllabus for the exam covers Knowledge Testing, Conceptual grasp, Analytical or Logical Exposition, Problem Solving and Case Analysis.

Qualification Criteria for IIBF

Graduate in any discipline or above from any UGC recognized University can appear for IIBF exam. Those appearing for final year graduation exam can also attend for the entrance test. But they will be awarded with the IIBF certificate only after submission of Graduate Degree Certificate.

Application Procedure for IIBF

Application form can be downloaded from the official website of IIBF. It is also available from the Institute's Zonal Offices, Corporate Office and at such other centres notified from time to time. The duly filled application form has to send to the Zonal office at Mumbai, New Delhi, Chennai and Kolkata. The candidates appearing for the first time has to pay Rs.3200 as registration fees and those appearing for the second time have to pay Rs. 800 only. The payment of the cash can be made with any AXIS branch using the payment challan form downloaded from the website.

Joint Admission Test 2010

Master of Finance and Control / Master of Business Economics

Last date for receipt of applications: 24 February, 2010

Date of Admission Test: 21 March, 2010

University of Delhi South Campus announces a Joint Admission Test for admission to the Two- Year (Full Time) Master of Finance and control (MFC) and Master of Business Economics (MBE) programme for the academic session 2010- 2012.

About the Programmes

Master of Finance and Control

MFC Programme opens a gateway to excellent career opportunities in Investment Banking, Equity Research, Wealth Management, Corporate Treasuries, Core Banking and Insurance, Real Estate and Commodity Markets, Business and Financial Counselling, Corporate Finance and other emerging areas in the financial sector.

Master of Business Economics

The MBE programme combines a sound conceptual grounding in basic Economics, Finance and Marketing, with intensive training in quantitative techniques like Econometrics and Operations Research.

Eligibility

Graduate (under 10 + 2 + 3) / Post-graduate in any discipline with 50% marks, from the University of Delhi or any other University recognised as equivalent thereto. Students appearing in the final year of Bachelor's Degree examination in 2010 are eligible to appear in the Joint Admission Test. However, they should meet the above-mentioned eligibility requirements latest by September 15, 2010

Note: The selected candidates must submit their final year results by September 15, 2010, failing which their admission will be automatically cancelled.

Selection Procedure

The shortlisting of the candidates for admission to the MFC and MBE programmes will be done on the basis of their performance in the Entrance Test. The Entrance Test will consist of multiple choice questions relating to English Comprehension and Verbal Ability, Analytical Reasoning, Data Interpretation and Data Sufficiency, Quantitative Ability (covering Basic Arithmetic, Algebra, Calculus, Basic Statistics and Data Analysis) and Current Business Environment. The result of the entrance test is expected by April 2, 2010.

The short listed candidates will be called for group discussion and personal interview.

How to Apply

The application form duly completed (accompanied by a self-addressed envelope of size 10" x 4.5" bearing postage stamp worth Rs. 25/- (If mailing address is outside Delhi and NCR) or postage stamp worth Rs. 12/- (if mailing address is in Delhi or NCR i.e., Gurgaon / Faridabad / Ghaziabad / NOIDA) for Admission Tickets to be sent via Speed Post) should reach the office of the Department of Financial Studies, Room No. 329 or Department of Business Economics, Room No. 229, University of Delhi, South Campus, Benito Juarez Road, New Delhi 110021 latest by February 24, 2010 (Forms will not be accepted on Saturday, Sunday and Holidays).

Application forms which have been downloaded from the website must be accompanied by a demand draft of appropriate amount favouring - The Director, University of Delhi, South Campus and mailed to or submitted at Department of Financial Studies, or at Department of Business Economics, Arts Faculty Building, University of Delhi, South Campus, Benito Juarez Road, New Delhi-110021. Candidates applying for both the courses must attach a demand draft of Rs. 1200/- (Rs. 500/- for SC/ST candidates) and those applying for only one course should attach demand draft for Rs. 700/- (Rs. 300/- for SC/ST candidates)

SC/ST/OBC candidates and candidates applying in the physically challenged category must submit a copy of caste/medical certificate along with the form. Applications without a valid caste/ medical certificate are liable to be rejected summarily. The candidates are advised to contact the University in case of any delay in receiving the Prospectus or Admission Ticket.
