

1. ATMA:

4. FMS: Admission to various management programs is done through a written test conducted by the FMS for itself. Eligible candidates are called for a written test and/or an interview for the Management admissions in FMS, University of Delhi. 7. **HP CMAT**: HP CMAT is entrance test conducted by IMS Institute of Management Studies Himachal Pradesh. 8. **IBSAT**: IBSAT Business School Aptitude Test 2010

IBSAT is an aptitude test conducted by the Federation of Universities (FedUni), for students seeking admission in

to the management programs. IBSAT consists of multiple choice questions.

IBSAT is for 2 hours duration and is aimed to test the applicant's ability in quantitative techniques, data interpretation, data adequacy, vocabulary, analytical reasoning and reading comprehension.

IBSAT 2010 Eligibility Criteria :

A bachelor's degree with medium of instruction as English, from any discipline, with 50% and above marks as calculated by respective University.

Applicants in their final year bachelor's degree course are also eligible to apply, provided they complete their graduation requirements including practical examinations / viva / assignments before January 31, 2011.

Such applicants will have to produce a certificate to that effect at the time of admission. For any extension of this deadline, the applicants should apply separately, giving the schedule of their graduation examination. Extension may be granted on the basis of the circumstances of the case. The admission of applicants will however, remain provisional until they produce marksheets and a degree certificate establishing their eligibility. Applicants who are appearing for backlog examinations of previous terms/semesters /year after January 31, 2010 are not eligible. The last date for submitting the proof of graduation is October 01, 2010, failing which the provisional admission will automatically stand cancelled.

For the purpose of determining eligibility (for all the programs) based on aggregate percentage of marks, the procedure used by the respective University in award of the degree will only be taken into consideration.

All applicants should have completed a minimum of 15 years of regular education (on 10+2+3 or 10+2+4 basis). Applicants who have completed their graduation on a one-time sitting basis or on a 2-year basis are not eligible.

Applicants not meeting the eligibility criterion of English medium have to submit the TOEFL/IELTS/NELTS scores by February 01, 2010.

14. MHT CET:

Maharashtra Common Entrance Test (MHCET) or MAH-MBA/MMS-CET is a written test for admission to First Year of two-year Full Time Post Graduate Degree Courses in MBA/MMS and PGDBM/PGDM in the Government, University Managed, University Departments and Unaided Institutes in the Maharashtra State. The written test is followed by a group discussion and personal interview.

Eligibility

Candidate should have passed with minimum of 50% marks in aggregate (45% marks in aggregate in case of candidates of backward class categories belonging to Maharashtra State only) in Bachelors degree/Masters Degree in any discipline recognised by the Association of Indian Universities.

15. NMAT:

Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharma) (IInd year lateral entry): For admission to second year (lateral entry) of B.Pharma the candidate must have passed Diploma in Pharmacy course; securing minimum 60% marks in aggregate

XAT

XLRI (Xavier Labour Relations Institute) Admission Test or XAT also known as the Xavier's Admission Test is a National level exam conducted by XLRI (Xavier Labour Relations Institute) to select the most appropriate students for management education. It is on the basis of XAT result that the eligible candidates are short listed and called for Personal Interview and/or Group Discussion. There are more than 70 Management Institutes who are selecting students from XAT 2010.

Eligibility

Candidates attempting the exam are required to have acquired a Bachelor's degree under 10+2+3 system from a recognized university or a deemed university. Those completing their final examination by June 10, 2011 may also apply.
