Campus:

Eligibility criteria:

A candidate must have attained an age of 17 years before 31st December, 2010 and should not be more than 22 years on 31st December, 2010. Besides a candidate should not be married and cannot marry even during the course. Also a candidate should be medically fit according to the specified standards.

Candidates should have passed all the subjects in the first attempt of qualifying examination and should have secured at least 60% marks in aggregate in Physics, Chemistry and Biology and at least 50% in each of these subjects individually and also in English.

Method of selection:

Candidates have to first give a written test. The syllabus of the written test will be same as 11th and 12th standard Syllabus. Those who clear the written test will be called for interviews and medical test at a later stage.

Eligibility Criteria for AIIMS MBBS:

To get admission in MBBS course in AIIMS a candidate has to pass class 12th with atleast 60% aggregate in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English. For SC/ST candidates the minimum aggregate required is 50%. Also a candidate should have attained the age of atleast 17 years by 31st December, 2011.

Pattern of examination:

AIIMS Entrance for MBBS is of three and a half hours duration having 200 multiple choice and reason-assertion type questions. There are 60 questions each from Physics, Chemistry and Biology and 20 questions from General Knowledge. There is negative marking for incorrect answers.

Assam JAT:

Candidates for admission into the Undergraduate Courses in the Engineering Colleges, Medical Colleges, Regional Dental College and Ayurvedic College of the State of Assam and NIT (Assam state quota) shall be selected strictly on the basis of merit of Joint Admission Test conducted by the Director of Technical Education, Assam in places and time notified by the Director of Technical Education in Assam Gazette and News papers every year. The test is normally held in the month of May every year.

About Exam:

Uttar Pradesh Combined Pre Medical Test is an entrance examination conducted by CSM Medical University, Lucknow on behalf of the Government of Uttar Pradesh for admission to various bachelor medical and dental courses like MBBS/BDS/BAMS/BHMS/BUMS in the medical and dental institutes in Uttar Pradesh. A large number of candidates from all over Uttar Pradesh appear for UPCPMT for admission in the best medical and dental institutes.

There are 41 Government/Private institutes in Uttar Pradesh in which admission is through UPCPMT 2011. Of these 8 institutes offer MBBS, 15 institutes offer BDS and the rest offer BAMS/BHMS/BUMS. The competition to get admission in MBBS and BDS courses is really tough so the students have to really work hard.

Eligibility Criteria:

Candidates should have a domicile of Uttar Pradesh.

A candidate should have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with atleast 50% aggregate marks(40% for SC/ST) in Physics, Chemistry and Biology. In addition candidates should have also passed English.

DU MET:

Delhi University Medical/Dental Entrance Test (DUMET) is an entrance exam for admission to the bachelor medical and dental courses MBBS and BDS in University of Delhi. DUMET is conducted by University of Delhi Faculty of Medical Sciences. The examination is conducted in the capital region of Delhi only. DUMET can only be given by candidates who have done 11th and 12th from Delhi.

MBBS is available in three colleges in University of Delhi which are Lady Harding Medical College, Maulana Azad Medical College and University College of Medical Sciences and Guru Tegh Bahadur Hospital and BDS is available in Maulana Azad Medical College. A large number of students appear for DUMET every year.

Eligibility criteria:

A candidate should have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology with atleast 50% aggregate marks in PCB (40% for SC/ST). Those who are appearing for class 12th exams in 2011 can also apply. Also, candidates that are mentally fit and free from any kind of illness will be allowed to sit in the Entrance Test. Candidates that have taken either Physics, English, Chemistry or Biology as an optional subject in their Higher Secondary Level are not allowed to sit for the Entrance Test.

Furthermore, Candidates that have to reappear in their 2011 10+2 Level or have fallen in Compartment or Improvement Genera are not allowed for admission even though they have cleared the Entrance Test. Also, Candidates that have failed in the first year of the professional degree from any recognized Medical based college within the permissible chances are also not allowed to sit in the written Entrance Test.

Availability of Application forms:

The forms for DUMET are expected to be available by February in Faculty of Medical Sciences, Delhi University and also from the member institutes. The form can also be obtained by post from Faculty of Medical Sciences, Delhi University by sending a Demand Draft along with the request for form.

The price of Application Form for candidates belonging to the General Castes is around Rs. 750 and for those belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribe is Rs. 550/. However the price of Application Form attained through post is Rs. 800/ for candidates that belong to the General Castes and for those belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribe is Rs. 600/. However it is to be strictly noted that the candidates belonging to the SC or ST genera have to suffice a certificate of caste providing their status.

Those who are appearing for class 12th exams in 2011 can also apply. Also a candidate should have attained the age of 17 years but not more than 25 years as on 31st December, 2011.

For Engineering Courses:

A candidate should have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with English, Physics, Mathematics and any of the Chemistry / Bio-Technology / Computer Science / Electronics / Biology with a minimum of 45% aggregate marks in optional subjects(40% for SC/ST/OBC). Those who are appearing for class 12th exams in 2011 can also apply.

For Architecture Course:

A candidate should have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with Mathematics with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks in all the subjects (45% for SC/ST/OBC). Those who are appearing for class 12th exams in 2011 can also apply. Candidates should have also appeared in NATA and got a minimum of 40% marks in it.

The forms for Karnataka CET will be available in schools and colleges of the Karnataka CET. For those residing outside Karnataka the form can be obtained by post from KEA by sending a Demand Draft along with the request for form.

TNPCEE: Tamil Nadu Professional Courses Entrance Examinations (TNPCEE 2011)

About Exam

Tamil Nadu Professional Courses Entrance Examinations (TNPCEE) is an entry level test conducted by Anna University, Chennai on behalf of the Government of Tamil Nadu for candidates who seek admission to all Professional Courses in Tamil Nadu. Besides Anna University there are many participating institutes of TNPCEE.

The rank of the students is determined on the basis of performance of the candidate in the TNPCEE 2011 and Class 12 Board Examination. The TNPCEE carries 100 marks whereas the Class 12 Board Examination carries 200 marks (marks secured in Class 12 Board Exam of Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry normalized to 100 marks, 50 marks and 50 marks respectively).

Eligibility

To appear in the TNPCEE 2011, candidates need to fulfill the following criteria.

Candidates should have passed the HSC or qualifying examination with certain minimum percentage of marks as specified in specific course.

For MBBS / BDS / B.Pharm / BSMS / BHMS / BPT / B.Sc Nursing/ B.Sc (Agriculture)/B.Sc (Forestry) / B.V.Sc / B.F.Sc courses candidates must have secured 60% in Biology or Botany and Zoology taken together and 60% in Physics and Chemistry taken together and aggregate of 140/200 in all the above subjects taken together.

Those who are appearing in the HSC or qualifying examination in the current year are also eligible for TNPCEE. 2011

There are relaxations of percentage of marks in case of backward class candidates.

Candidates should meet the nativity/domicile requirements of Tamil Nadu as laid down by the respective Admitting Authorities for admission to their Professional Courses.

Other State candidates are not permitted to some of the Professional Courses under TNPCEE.
